SCHEDULE

The trip begins with dinner Thursday evening, Nov. 7, followed by two days of visits. We'll observe mountaintop removal sites and meet with local leaders, activists and residents. Participants travel home on Nov. 10.

COSTS

Participants will each cover their own transportation to Big Stone Gap, Va., accommodations in a local hotel (we will reserve a block of rooms and provide you with contact information), and most meals.

The trip fee of \$350 covers activity costs, speaker honoraria, trip leadership, and a gift to our hosts, the Southern Appalachian Mountains Stewards (samsva.org).
